The Antimatter Festival of Short Film and Video packs in even more underground flicks this weekend at Open Space (510 Fort), with 10 separate programs spread over four nights, including two special guest-curated screenings of work from Latin America and the Czech Republic and Slovakia. Here's a few more highlights to watch out for:

Electrum (Sept. 22, 7:00 pm)

Few documentaries are quite as shocking as this one. Alberta Chu's camera follows million-volt man Greg Leyh, a high voltage engineer commissioned by a rich New Zealand rancher-cum-art-patron to create, with the late Eric Orr, the world's largest lightning-producing Tesla coil. Welcome to the fascinating sub-culture of San Francisco's Survival Research Laboratories and the resident electro-geeks determined to play Zeus.
